Care home for elderly teachers

A special care home for single retired teachers, artists, artisans still active in education, elderly care, local history (Homoródmente).

Definition of a new care home ensuring not only accessible accommodation and care, but avoiding loneliness as well. Accommodation for 20-30 elderly people.

The definition of the exact function is part of the design task as well. The main point is to be familylike homes. The retired teachers could get a "service flat" this way. The existing teacher flats may be examined, or a new home can be designed as well.

The building's situation and connection with all the existing buildings of the village centre and the topography should be an important aspect of the design.

Workshop house and craftsman school

The goal of the workshop house is to serve the local handicrafts. It aims to be the background for local industry of handicrafts scale for real local needs.

Currently the diary is the most important industrial establishment of the village. However, there are neither craftsman diary products offered, nor diary shop. Similarly, a general service workshop for serving daily life of the village (cars, agricultural vehicles) is missing as well. Furthermore, a carpenter and furniture maker workshop is needed as well.

Possibly all, but at least two of these workshops should be situated in the workshop house based on common evaluation and decision of student and tutor.

In Homoródszentpál in the area around the Unitarian church there are the relics of a camp of an aid troop guarding the Eastern borders of Roman province Dacia. For over a decade there is a continuous research work going on in more counties for the Eastern Limes in Dacia as part of an interregional project. The excavations in Homoródszentpál have turned into a quite serious research during the past two years. The design task is to create an archaeological base ensuring researchers accommodation and basic scientific infrastructure and storage facilities.
